Heritage University to Host Monotype Workshop

Toppenish, Wash. – Heritage University will host two sessions of a monotype printmaking workshop on February 12, 2016. Master printer Frank Janzen from Crow's Shadow Institute of Arts will lead these sessions for participants. This art form is a quick and easy way to create unique, one-ofa-kind prints. Participants in the sessions will be able to create anything they like, from realistic landscapes to abstract prints, or anything in between. The art doesn't have to have a specific theme, and no experience is necessary to create monotypes.

Various techniques of monotype printmaking will be explained, including additive and subtractive methods, use of stencils, as well as proper inking methods using rollers and brushes. Janzen will provide time for individual instruction.
