When the transaction is complete, the agreement will expand access and build an even stronger network of care for people in the region.

This fits well with our vision to be the region's comprehensive healthcare provider of choice," continued Gallagher.

Each of the hospitals is respected in their communities, with histories of caring for patients extending back for decades.

The transaction is expected to be complete in the second quarter of next year, subject to customary regulatory approvals and closing conditions.
