The pass gets the holder into the Fair all ten days for just \$25. Because there is free seating at all of the Fair concerts, it also allows the holder to see all of the entertainers for just the price of admission.

This year is the 125th anniversary of the Central Washington State Fair. There will be other special events, attractions and entertainers announced in the near future.
