LSN enhances data network availability with a major fiber optic network build into the Yakima area.

Yakima, WA- LSN, a telecommunications company local to the Pacific Northwest, recently completed their first fiber build into the Yakima Valley. Construction on the network, which started in spring 2012, was completed around the same time as the Tri Cities build, in late 2013. During the peak in constructing this latest phase of the LSN deployment approximately 250 direct and indirect jobs were supported.
