## Heritage University Faculty Member Named Among Top 100 Leadership Speakers for 2018

Toppenish, Wash. – Dr. Matt Kincaid, an associate professor of business at Heritage University, is named on *The Top 100 Leadership Speakers for 2018* list as published by Inc. Magazine. The authors describe the benefits of candid communication, illustrate the inhibitors that prevent it from happening, and offer tools for leaders to cultivate a culture where everyone, regardless of rank or status, is encouraged to speak freely.
