

**SUBJECT: PLEASE SIGN UP TO OPPOSE HB 1091**

Dear Members,

I am writing to let you know that the House Energy & Environment Committee will host a hearing next Thursday, Jan. 14 starting at 1:30 p.m. on [HB 1091](#), a proposed Low Carbon Fuel Standard (LCFS).

As you know, this costly and ineffective mandate would force billions of dollars in added fuel and infrastructure costs, burdening families and businesses amid a fragile economy. What is more, an LCFS would provide NO money for transportation improvements and analysis shows that more than 70 percent of LCFS compliance dollars would likely leave Washington state as fuel suppliers in our state would have to purchase a majority of compliance fuels from out-of-state producers. And, studies estimate that any potential reductions in greenhouse gas (GHG) emissions from an LCFS in our state would be insignificant.

**Legislators need to hear your voice in opposition to this costly and ineffective bill – especially during this unprecedented all-remote legislative session.**

Below are three simple ways to share your position on a bill: You can sign up to testify during the hearing, submit written testimony, or simply sign in to register your opposition to the bill without providing testimony. Attached you will find a quick overview of that process if you want to testify next week or at any time throughout the 2021 legislative session.
